

## **What to Bring Checklist for Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid – the FAFSA**

- ☐ Student's social security number. Have the card to ensure number is correct.
- ☐ Parents' social security numbers. Have the card to ensure number is correct.
- ☐ Parents' date of birth.
- ☐ Student's driver's license or state non-driver ID.
- ☐ Parent's driver's license or state non-driver ID.
- ☐ Student's Permanent Alien Registration Number, if not a U.S. citizen.
- ☐ Copy of student's 2020 Federal Income Tax Return and 2018 W-2 Form(s).
- ☐ Copy of parents' 2020 Federal Income Tax Return and 2018 W-2 Form(s).
- ☐ Records of student's 2020 untaxed income for the following sources of income:
  - Child support received for any of the student's children
  - Interest income
  - Veterans non-education benefits
  - Money received by or paid on the student's behalf (bills, for example)
- ☐ Records of parents' 2020 untaxed income for the following sources of income:
  - Child support received for all children
  - Interest income
  - Veterans non-education benefits
  - Untaxed portion of pension benefits
  - Untaxed payments to tax deferred pensions and retirement savings plans
  - Untaxed portion of IRA distributions
  - Workers' compensation benefits
  - Disability benefits
- ☐ Student *and* Parent Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) usernames and passwords.
  - Preferable to create one before attending the FAFSA completion session. Create the FSA ID at [fsaid.ed.gov](https://fsaid.ed.gov).
- ☐ Valid email address for student-not a high school email address.
- ☐ Valid email address for parent.
